VENERAN NONPROFIT PARINERS

We are so proud of everything our nonprofit partners have achieved this year and we look forward to seeing what they accomplish in the future.



Our True North compass signifies what each organization has accomplish since partnering with the True North Foundation.



The Dog Tag Fellowship Program equips veterans, military spouses, and caregivers with the tools and education to build resilience, find renewed purpose, and forge community beyond the military.



Since 2019 Dog Tag has graduated 104 students and they recently expanded to a second location in Chicago.





The Heroes Journey, led by Lieutenant Colonel Scott Mann, is an organization with a passion for storytelling. They work directly with veterans, first responders, and their families to help them find their voice and tell their story in their transition from service to civilian life.



Since 2016, The Heroes Journey has touched the lives of thousands of veterans through productions of the play "Last Out: Elegy of a Green Beret." With the recent release of the filmed recording of this production, they anticipate that their impact will increase exponentially.





Founded in 1962, The Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation provides access to affordable education for the children of Marines and Navy Corpsmen attending post-high school, undergraduate and career technical education programs.



Since 2019 the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation has awarded 7,170 scholarships, with \$30,000 sponsored by our corporate partner, Semper Capital Management





Merging Vets and Players (MVP) empowers combat veterans and former professional athletes by connecting them after the uniform comes off; providing them with a new team to assist with transition, promote personal development, and show them they are never alone.



Since 2020 MVP has added three locations; for a total of eight, and created a virtual platform giving participants the ability to obtain support from anywhere.





Stay In Step is a veteran founded and run organization that provides long term rehabilitation and therapy to both veterans and civilians that suffer from a spinal cord and/or traumatic brain injury, or any other neurological disorder resulting in paralysis in the Greater Tampa Bay and surrounding areas.



Since 2016 Stay In Step has expanded to a new facility allowing them to service over 130 clients per week.

SVA Conference with MVP

In January, MVP hosted a large workout and huddle at the Student Veterans of America Conference in Orlando, FL. To help support MVP, the True North Foundation donated water bottles and wristbands and foundation staff volunteered their time at the event.

MCSF in San Francisco

In April, the True North Foundation hosted a cocktail party to kick off the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation's board meeting week. This event brought together veteran advocates in the greater San Francisco area.

MCSF Leatherneck Ball

In May, representatives from the True North Foundation attended the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation's Leatherneck Ball in New York City. It was a beautiful event that helped highlight the record numbers that the foundation hit in 2021. They awarded 2,505 scholarships amounting \$9.2 million!

Stay In Step New York Week

In May, the True North Foundation sponsored a week of fundraising for our nonprofit partner, Stay In Step. The foundation hosted two events with the help of Pride Global in New York City and the South End Restaurant in New Canaan, CT, resulting in over \$41,000 raised for their organization.

Stay In Step Gala

In September, representatives of the True North Foundation attended the annual Stay In Step Gala in Tampa Bay, FL. The event highlighted all the wonderful work Stay In Step does in the brain and spinal cord rehab community as well as celebrated the opening of their brand new facility!

Dog Tag Volunteer Work

Throughout the year, members of the True North family donated their time and expertise to Dog Tag, Inc.'s Workshops, Learning Labs, and Capstone Projects.
